We are grateful for being part of implementing this technology to help share the Gospel.

Lately, Dann has been maintaining and improving ITeams information technology. One example: To reduce the cost of postal mail the system has been updated. Donors now have the ability to receive digital notifications when their gifts have been processed rather than receiving a monthly statement by mail. Dann has also been called on to help resolve problems with the building's HVAC system.



Last time we wrote, we were planning a journey to **Ghana** with Two Pennies Ministry. The journey began March 24. Dann was part of the team which equipped the library with ten work stations and two servers for this remote community. It was incredible that the team set up wireless access to the school for the students' education as most of the school's buildings have no electricity.

Nancy sorted and organized books for the library. She assisted with the beginnings of sack gardening for many of the families. Others in our team helped start a pig farm and also conducted a conference for area



pastors. The children at Love and Care Orphanage are doing great; they have recently been able to enroll in a better school and are progressing like crazy. Worshiping God in the African style was quite amazing as well. Thank you so much to those who made this trip possible with your prayers and financial support.

Benjamin is kept extremely busy as a manager for Panera, working in DeKalb




Matthew moved to a new apartment in Chicago. He was able to help a neighbor that was shot. He now has a cat.
